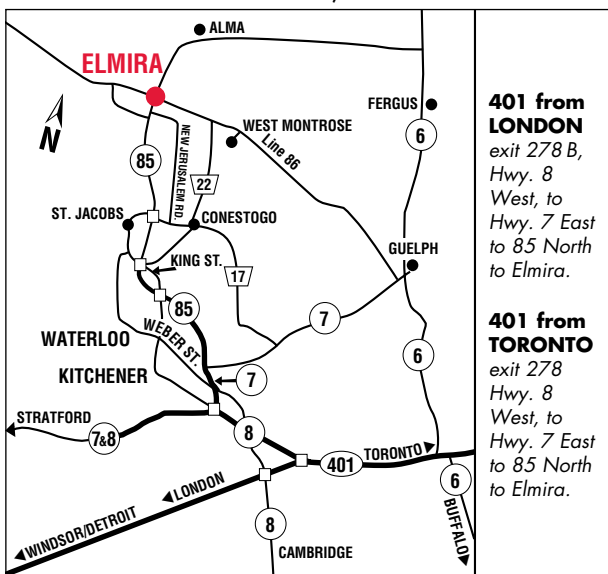
DISPERSION OF FUNDS
